1. Base extension adjustment and wheels installation

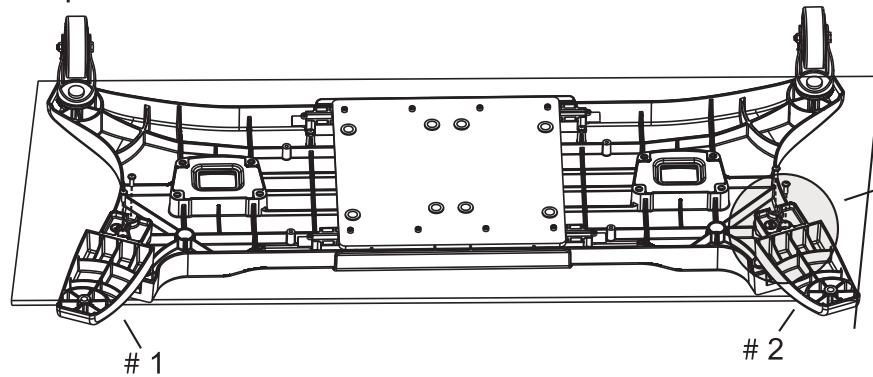
Step 1:
Take sheet foam from box and lay it on floor.



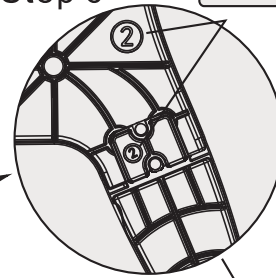

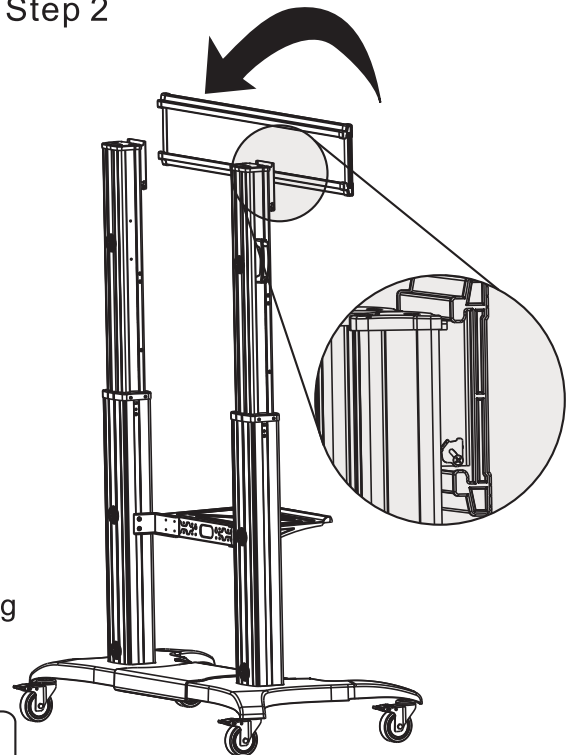


6. TV interface to columns installation

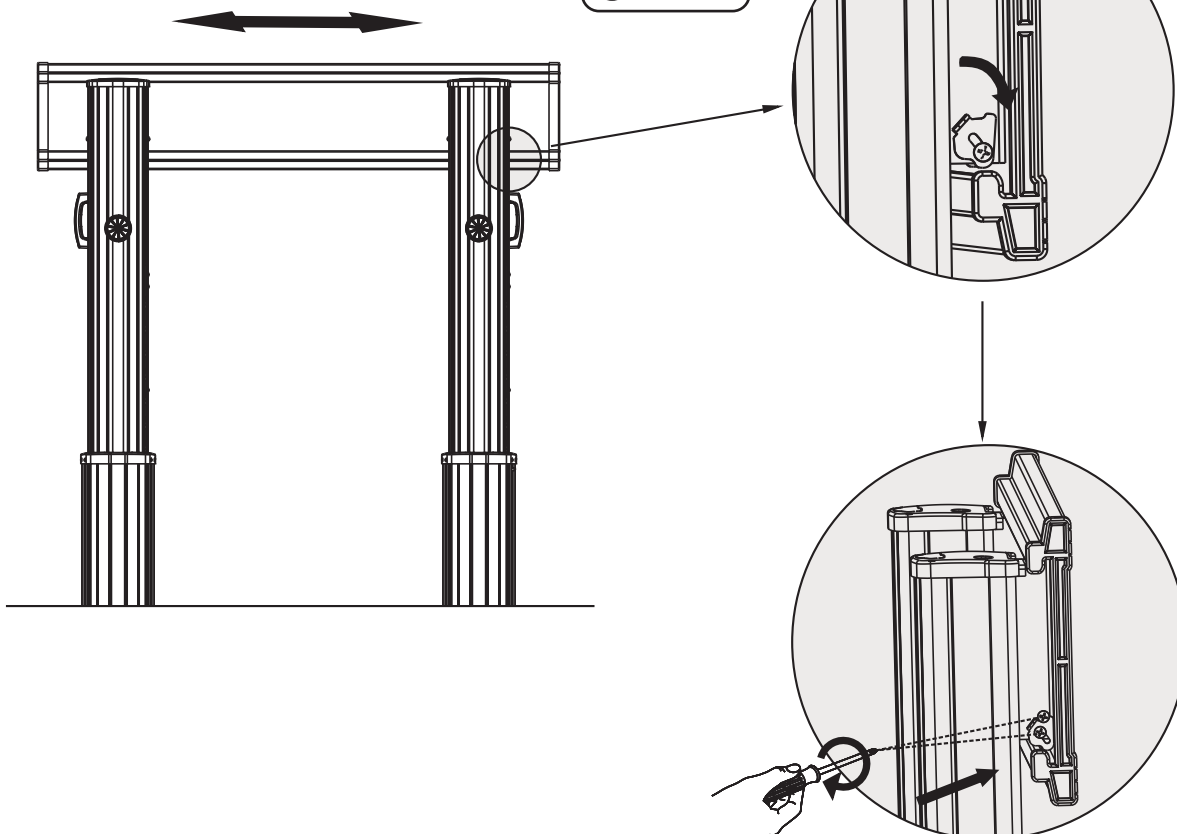
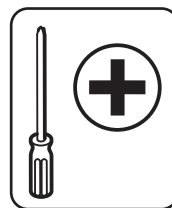

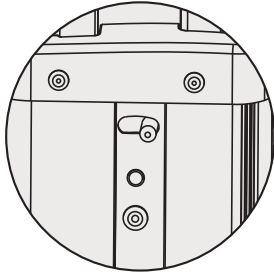

7. Height adjustment

Step : If required height needs to be lower down, need 2 men. One man holds onto interface assembly, the other release screw at side, and slide stopper catch backward and hold, 1st man allow interface assembly slide down slowly until the desired height, free stopper catch and it will back to its original place. Tighten screw.



Warning:  Be sure the stopper catch rest at palace.

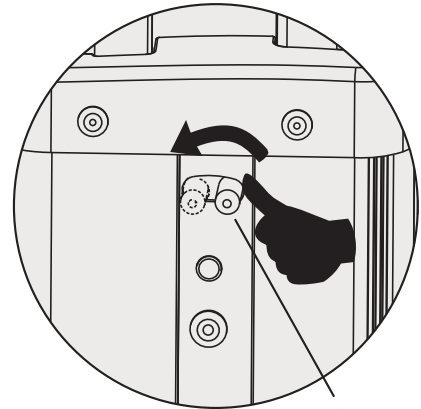


Figure 1 Stopper catch

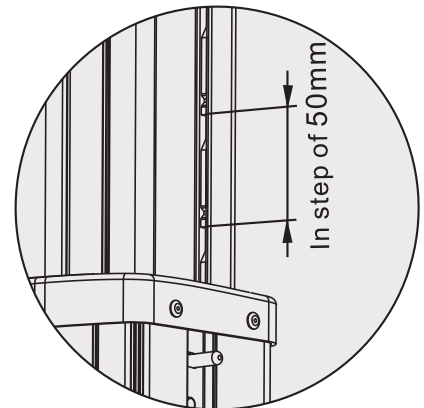

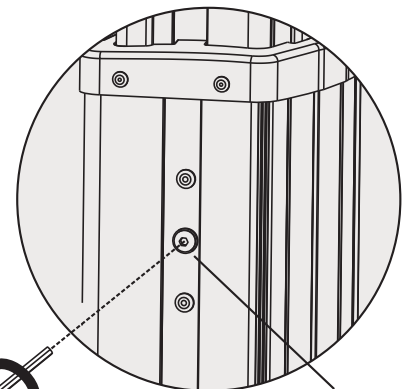
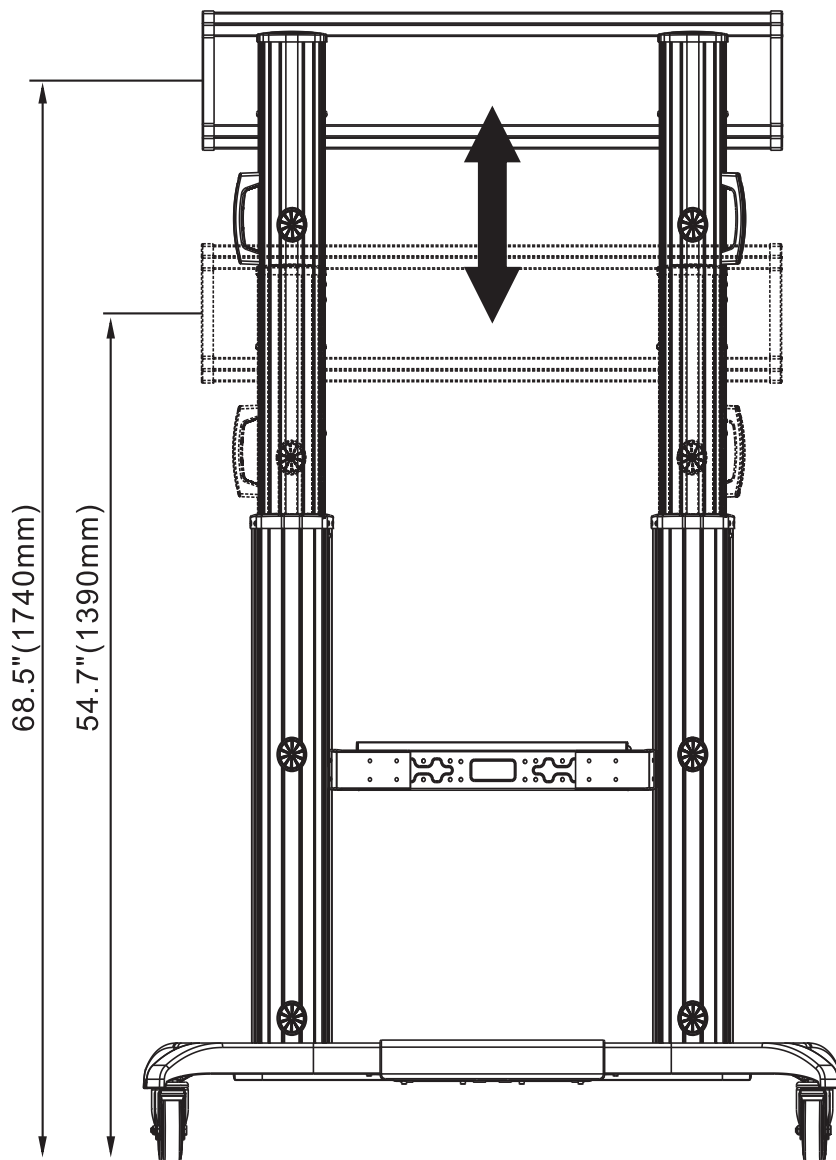
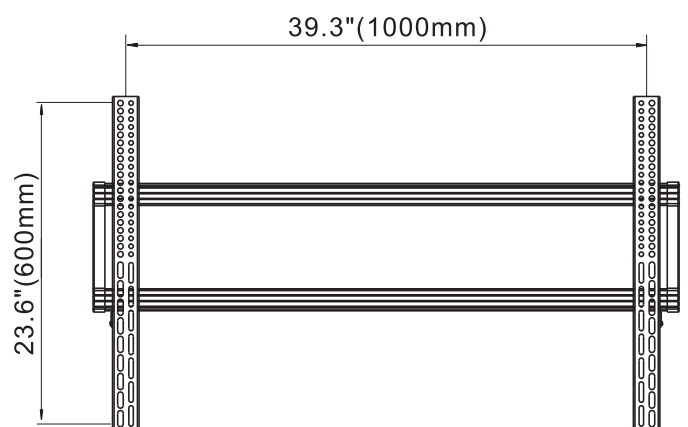
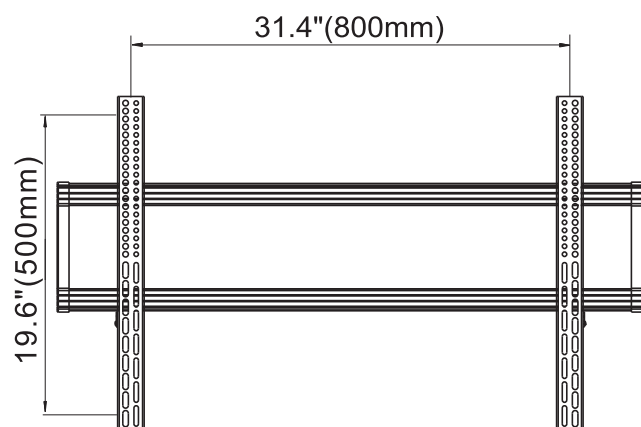
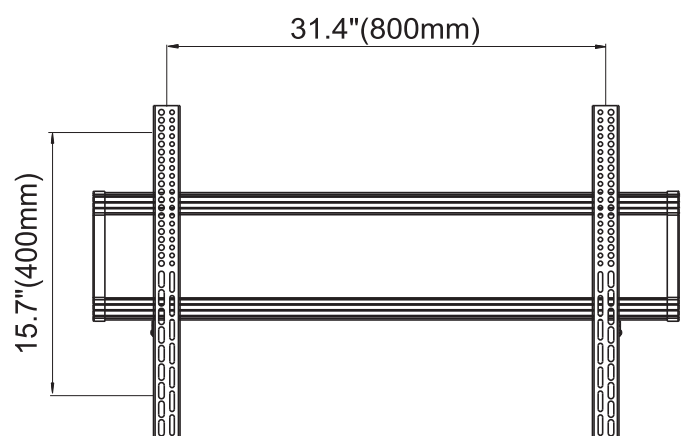
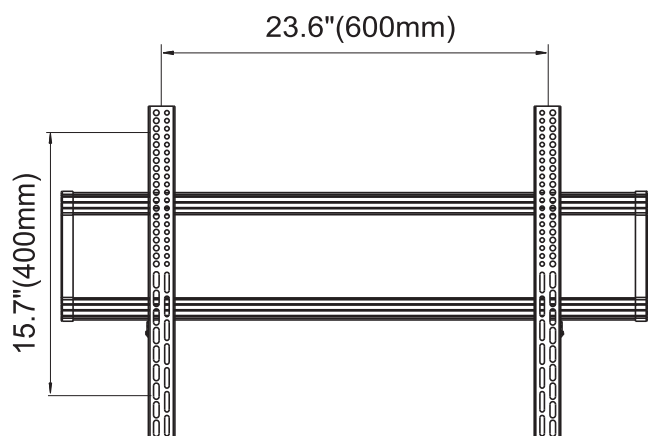
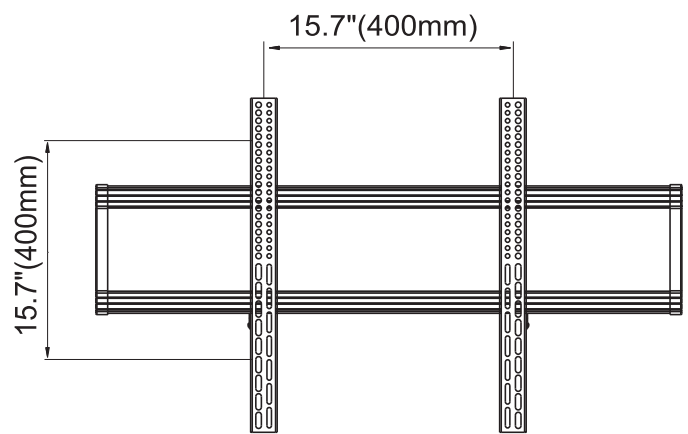
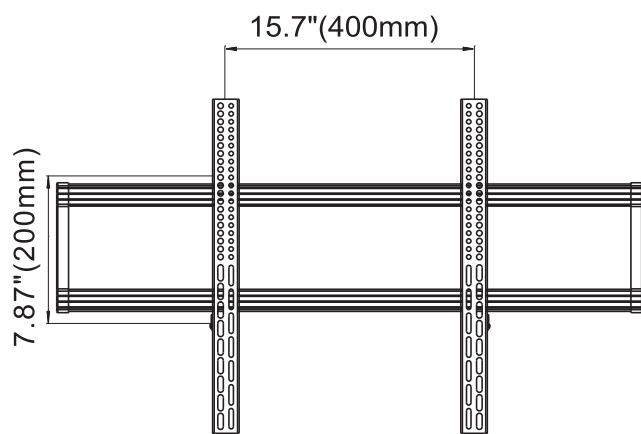
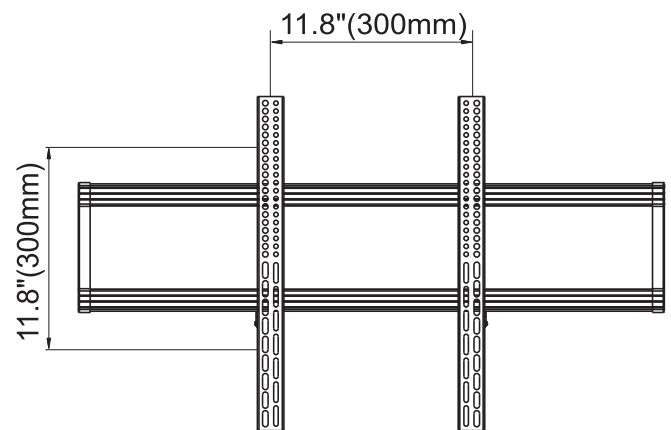
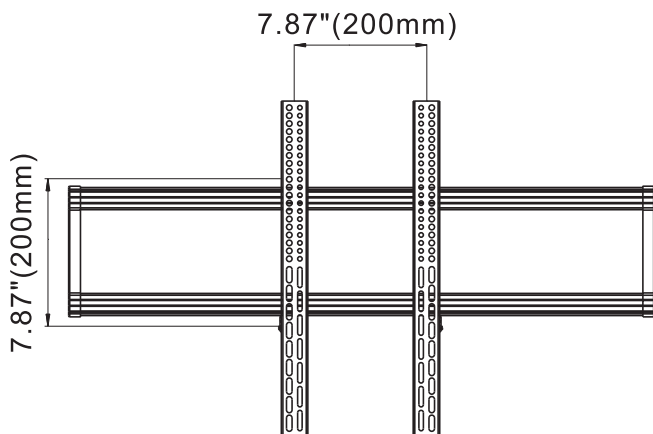


Figure 3 Jammed screw



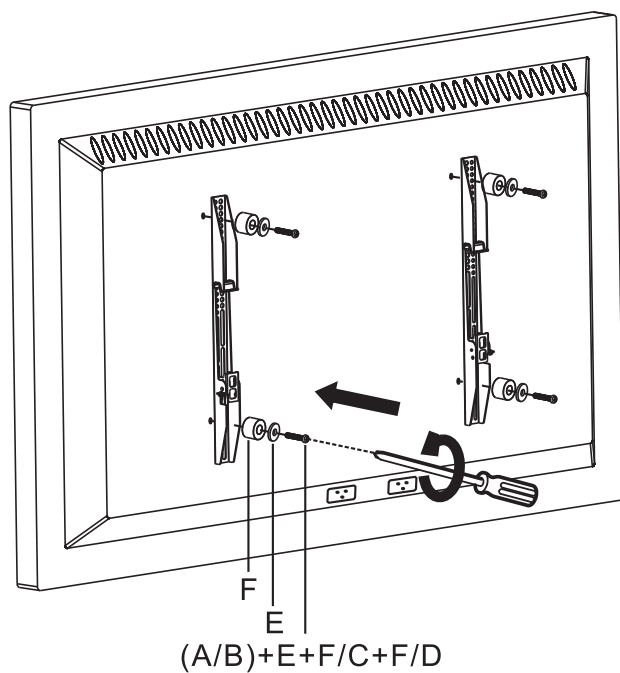

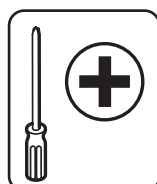
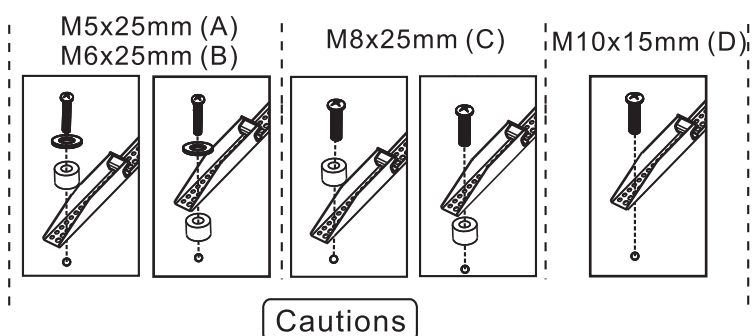
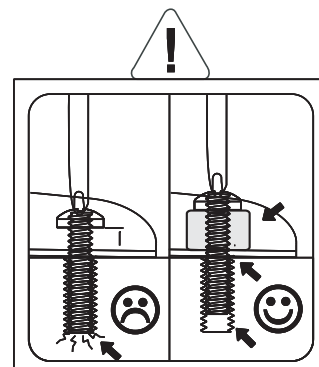
9. Selection of VESA mounting patterns
