Release screw at side


Step 3

In step of 50mm







Step 5 Repeat step 1 to 4 on the other column 2




### 3. TV interface tilt heads to columns installation




# 4. Columns to base installation




### 6. TV interface to columns installation




#### 7. Height adjustment

Step: If required height needs to be lower down, need 2 men. One man holds onto interface assembly, the other release screw at side, and slide stopper catch backward and hold, 1st man allow interface assembly slide down slowly until the desired height, free stopper catch and it will back to Its original place. Tighten screw.






#### Note:

To avoid damage plastic spacers must be used when depth of mounting holes is at minimal.







